

Chill, It's a Drill!

On Wednesday, March 28th between 9:45 AM and 10:15 AM the Kenai Peninsula Borough will be participating in a statewide exercise to test tsunami alert systems. You may hear tsunami sirens and, if you are watching TV or listening to the radio, you may hear or see a message that a tsunami warning has been issued for all of Alaska. However, it's just a test to make sure that the tsunami warning system works from one end to the other. So tell your friends and family:

1. It's not a real emergency
2. Do not evacuate your home
3. Do not call 911
4. The siren will say "Attention, a tsunami warning has been issued for this area. Turn to your local radio station for details."

So remember March 28th 9:45 to 10:15 *Chill, it's a Drill!*
