COLD WEATHER CLOTHING

Dear Parents / Guardians:

Cold, wet weather is here! Appropriate clothing is needed to keep your child warm and dry. School policy states that all children will go outside at recess unless the chill factor exceeds -10 degrees or it's raining significantly. Studies have shown that fresh air and exercise increase a child's ability to learn in the classroom, even for those who have, or are recovering from, a minor illness. Please consider the following guidelines:

1. **Water repellent hat, coat and foot gear for damp, puddly days.**
2. **Mittens or gloves:** Mittens are generally warmer and are recommended.
3. **Clothing:** Several layers of light clothing that fit comfortably without binding are recommended instead of a single heavy, bulky layer. Snowsuits and/or snow pants are recommended for both boys and girls.
4. **Cap or Ski-Band:** Should be worn even if your child's coat or snowsuit has a hood. Hoods frequently do not stay in place or fit snugly enough around the ears.
5. **Foot Gear that will keep the feet dry:** Insulated boots or boots worn over the shoe provide good protection. Both types should be removed when indoors. Boots worn indoors cause feet to perspire and become damp. Wet feet will become cold feet on the next trip outdoors.
6. **A light shoe** (i.e. tennis shoes) **should remain in the classroom for indoor wear.**
7. **Stocking feet are not adequate in case of a fire drill.**
8. **All removable clothing should be labeled with your child's name.**

As a general rule, children who are well enough to attend school benefit from outdoor recess time. Please let us know if your child is recovering from an illness. We will make an extra effort to make sure their outdoor clothing is in place during recess.

If you have extra mittens, hats or other cold weather clothing that is still in good condition, please consider donating it to the school. Children who don't have adequate winter clothing, or whose clothing became wet during a previous recess, are then able to borrow the appropriate items and enjoy a warm and dry recess.
