HOMEWORK CLUB AGREEMENT

To all the Parents/Guardians:

We are pleased to announce the establishment of the Chapman Homework Club. We will offer this club Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday every week from 3:12-4:00. We strive to create the Homework Club as a productive workplace without disruption for its members. Please read this contract with your son or daughter and return it signed in order for your child to participate in this program.

The Chapman Homework Club is an opportunity for students to use the library resources, to work quietly on assignments or projects, and receive help from a certified staff member of Chapman School when necessary. Students will be required to take initiative and use their time in the Homework Club wisely.

Before we begin the club, we would like to make you aware that students may be asked to leave if they have no work to do or if they are being disruptive. Any student removed from the program will receive a Dismissal Report that will be sent home to be signed and returned in order for the student to participate in the Homework Club in the future. In addition, a phone call to the parent will follow.

We look forward to having your child in homework club!

RULES

1. Each student must have a Homework Club agreement on file to participate (that is this page!)
2. Homework Club starts at 3:12 and ends at 4:00. Students will need a pass if they are late and a note from a parent or staff member if they are leaving early.
3. Students must sign in upon entering.
4. Bring all necessary materials for homework.
5. Work quietly and independently.
6. If you finish your homework, read a book or newspaper quietly.
7. You must be picked up on time. Rides more than 5 minutes late will be counted as an "offense." (see below)
8. You must have a pass to leave the Homework Club meeting room.
9. No iPods or other electronics allowed, except with the permission of your homeroom teacher for a specific assignment.
10. Snacks will not be provided – if you need a snack, bring one from home and finish it by 3:20.

CONSEQUENCES

First Offense: You will receive a verbal warning and moved to a quiet spot.

Second Offense: You will be asked to leave the Homework Club. You may return to the homework club ONLY after you have had your Dismissal Report signed by a parent and returned.

Third Offense: In order for you to return after the second dismissal, a meeting must be scheduled with the parents, the Homework Club Advisor (Mrs. Simonsen), and Mr. Woodhead, your classroom teacher, or Mrs. Debbie.
