## OPTIONS: KPBSD SOUTHERN PENINSULA SCHOOL START AND END TIMES

Changes to school start and end times will take effect in August, 2017. Parents, KPBSD staff, students, and community members are invited and encouraged to attend a community meeting to learn about the three options for new school start and end times and provide input. The same content will be presented at each meeting:

- **Ninilchik: Tuesday, November 1, 2016, 6:00 PM, Ninilchik School**
- **Homer: Wednesday, November 2, 2016, 6:00 PM, Homer High School**
- **Anchor Point: Thursday, November 10, 6:00 PM, Chapman School**

Following community meetings and feedback from community members, school principals met with district administration and staff to develop three options for new school start and end times in the southern peninsula. The preferred option from all school administrators is "X". However, two additional options were developed. Option "Y" adds ten minutes to start and end times, and option "Z" is most problematic, swaps the start times, and tiers schools without like needs.

- The transportation department analyzed X, Y, and Z options, and transportation routes for X and Y are viable.
- School administrators will share the three options with site councils, and gather input.
- November community meetings will be an excellent time for a shared conversation and discussion.

- KPBSD transportation will make certain bus transportation for the chosen option is viable.
- The district anticipates completion and a final decision before winter break so that parents and communities can begin to plan for the changes that will start in August, 2017.
